Call to Confession

Leader: Friends, God is right here with us—closer than we think. And that’s exactly why we can be honest with ourselves and our God. Because so often we rush through our days, we miss the sacred in front of us, and we get caught up in our own worries and wants. We overlook Christ in other people, and we don’t always treat God’s creation like the gift it is. So, let’s take a breath, tell the truth, and come back to God. Let us pray our confession together.

Corporate Prayer of Confession

All: Merciful God, we confess that we don’t always live like you are here with us. We rush, worry, and focus on what we want, and we miss your grace in the ordinary. Forgive us for overlooking Christ in others—especially those who are hard to love or easy to ignore. Forgive us for treating your creation as something to use instead of a gift to cherish. Slow us down. Open our eyes and soften our hearts. Teach us to notice, to be astonished, and to live with gratitude. By your Spirit, help us reflect your love in the world. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.

Leader: Let us take a moment for silent confession and personal reflection.

Assurance of Pardon

Leader: Hear the good news: the God who is present in all things is also rich in mercy. In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven—not because we finally got it right, but because God’s grace is steady and true. So, lift up your hearts. If even the stones can cry out with praise, then we can rise in hope. In Christ, your sins are forgiven, and you are made new. Thanks be to God. Amen.
